

Southern Indiana Power awards Operation Round Up grants

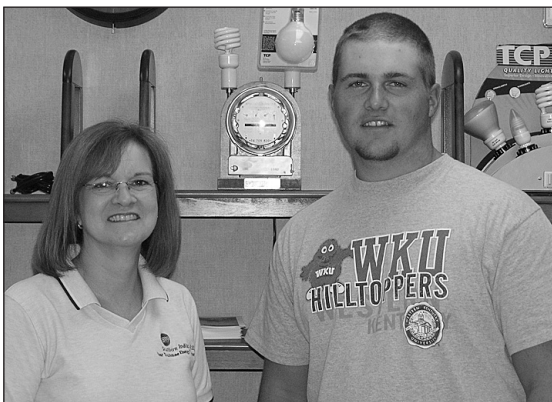
